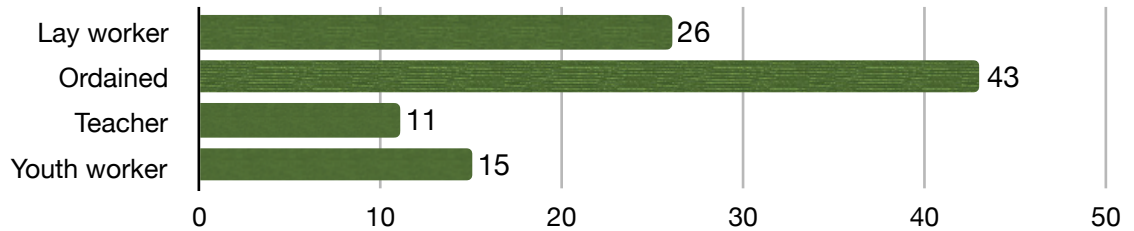
## Part 2 – Questions 12 - 25, 'About you as a Chaplain'

There were 102 responses. The number answering is shown in brackets after the question. Some questions had more than one answer.

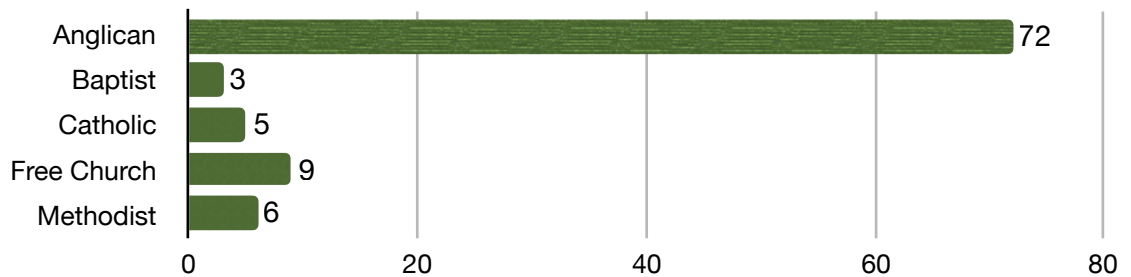
### 12. What best describes your situation when you started chaplaincy? (100)

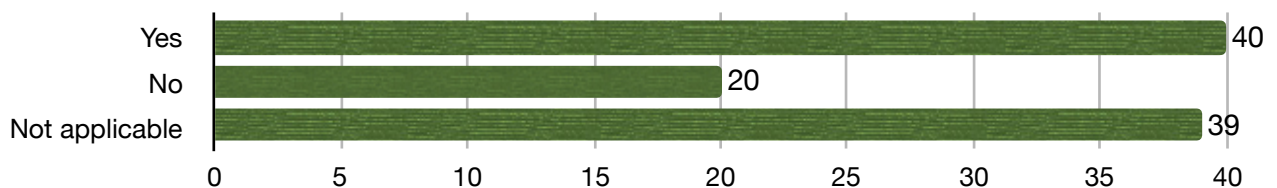
### 13. What type of church do you belong to? (102)

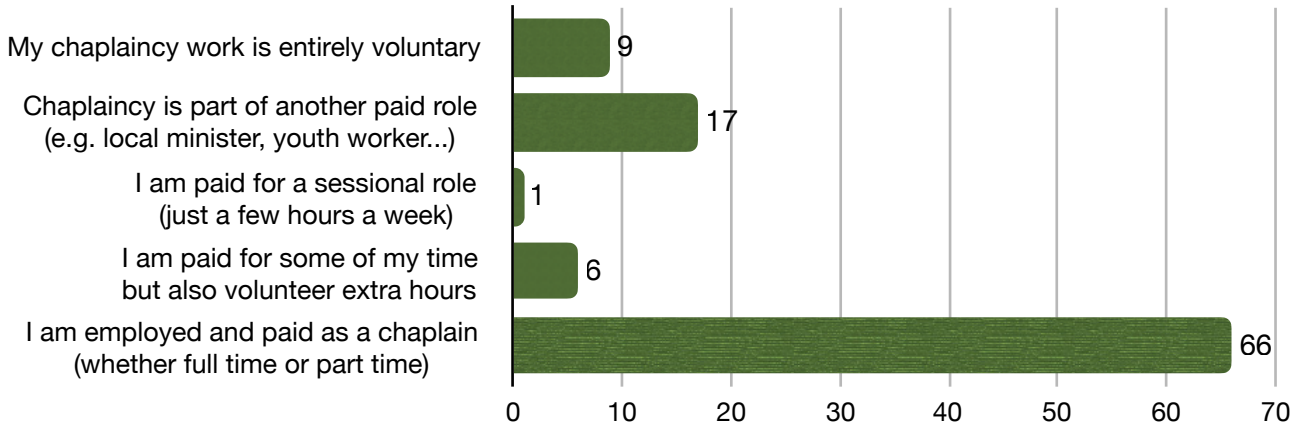
### 14. If you work in a church school or faith school is your current church affiliation the same as the place you serve? (100)

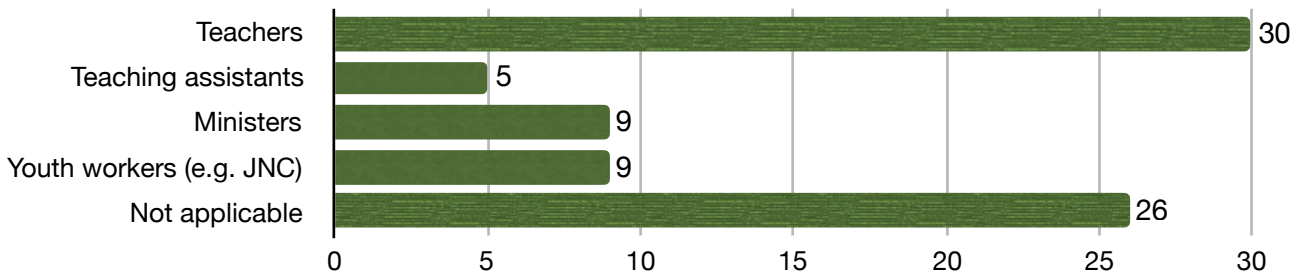
**15. Are you paid for your work as chaplain? (100)**

**16. If you are paid for your work as a Chaplain, what pay scale are you linked to? (93)**

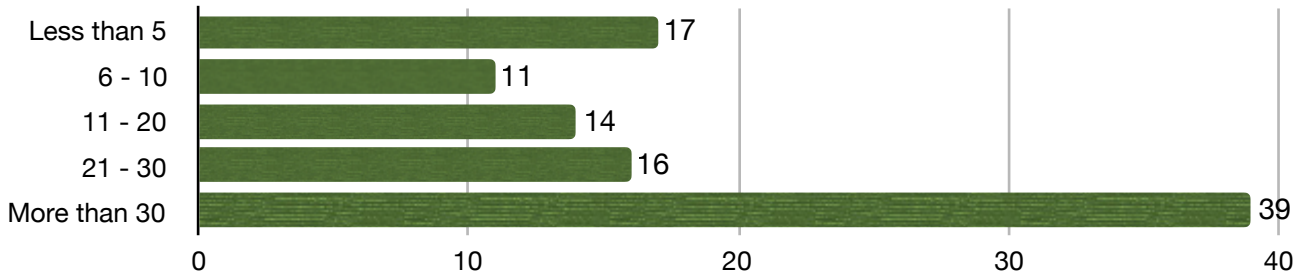

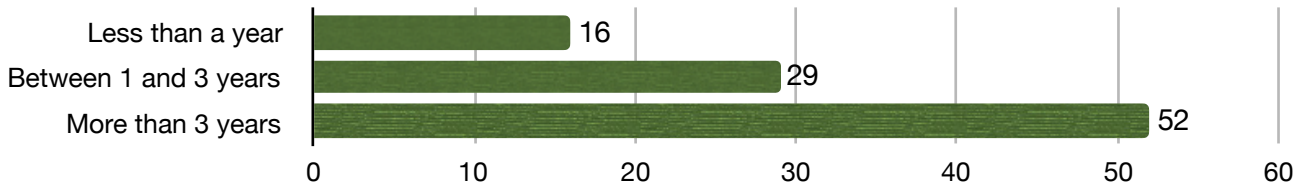

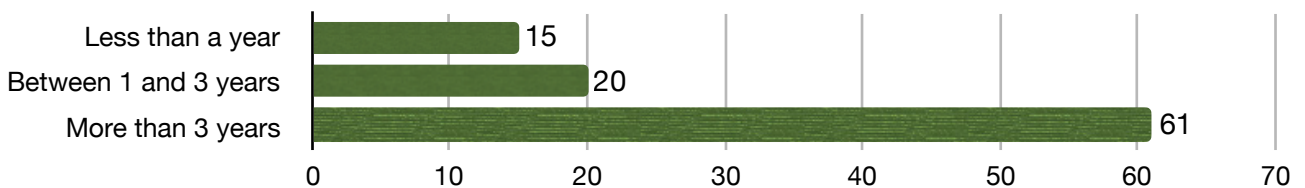

## 20. Which of the following best describes the way you were recruited into educational chaplaincy? (99)



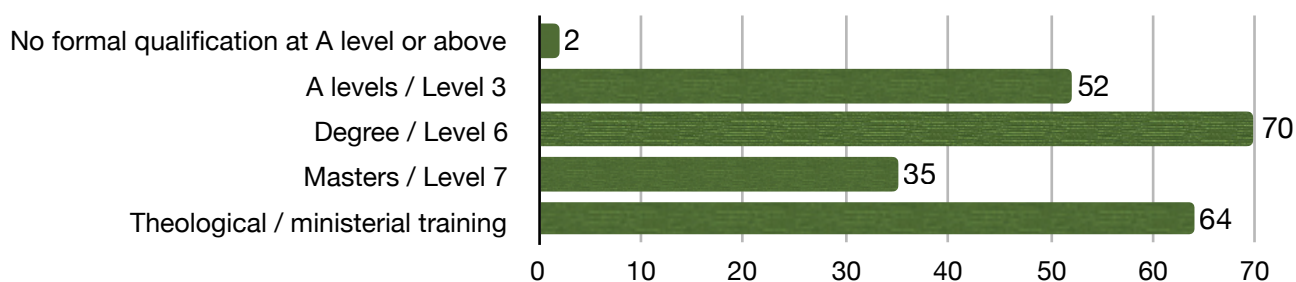
### **Other:**

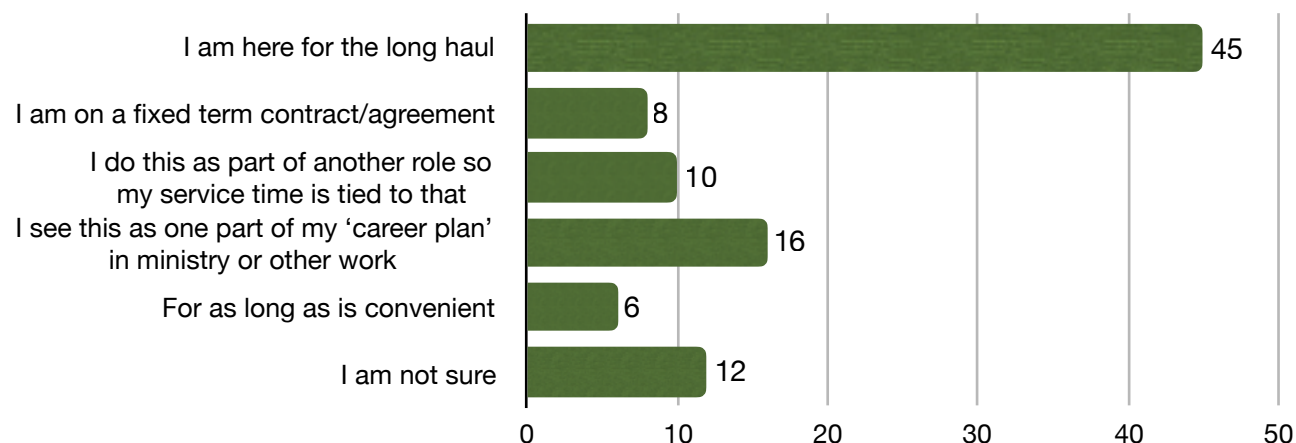

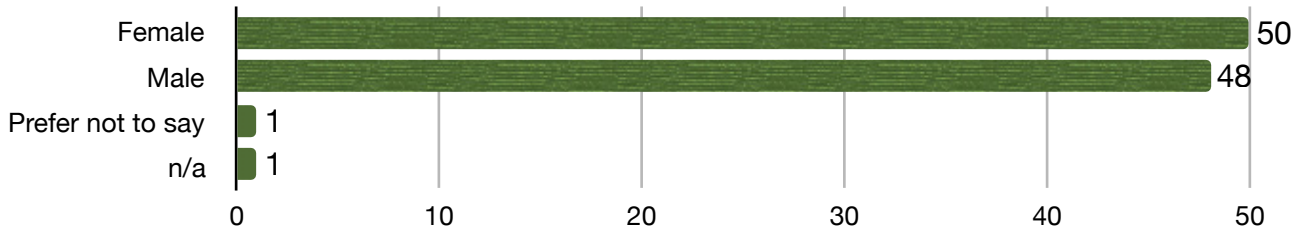
## 22. Which sentence best describes your future plans? (101)

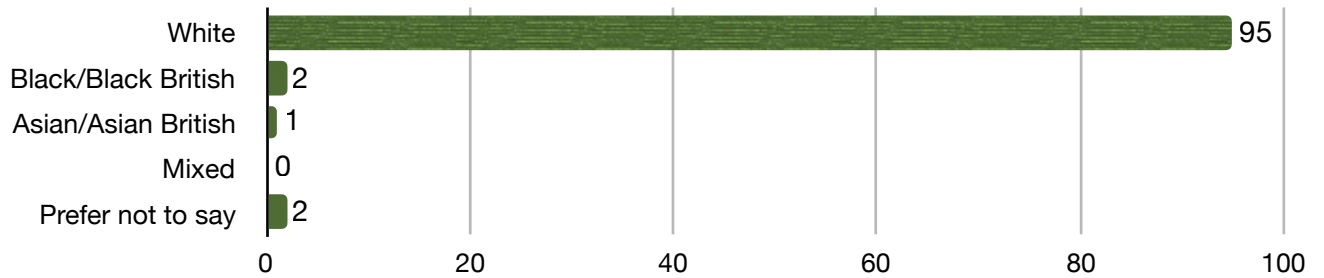
